

STABLE-2007/ACUTE-2007 RECERTIFICATION TRAINING

ABOUT THE SESSION

The Stable-2007/Acute-2007 Recertification course is designed to refresh practitioners on how to score the SARATSO mandated dynamic risk instruments for sexual offending. With time, scorers may evidence scoring drift and/or scorer's biases, so this refresher is provided to maintain consistent inter-rater reliability when scoring the instrument. Participants will review the items that are the basis of the Stable-2007 and Acute-2007 instruments, which include a list of dynamic risk factors, the underlying psychological factors for each item, the criteria for scoring the items, and how to identify and analyze the data associated with scoring each item. The interpretation of the instrument, includes risk estimates and risk-levels for use in court settings, and informs the use of the risks-needs responsivity principal, in relation to dosage, intensity and targets of treatment. Attendees will review a pre-course discussion case during the class and take a post-test at the end of the class to evidence proficiency in scoring. **A new feature of this course is the inclusion of an interrater reliability study using a recorded session with an offender to give students a true field experience. Participants are required to score the video, and may participate in the optional IRR survey at the end of the course.**
